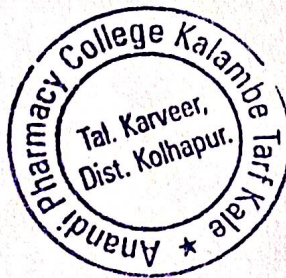

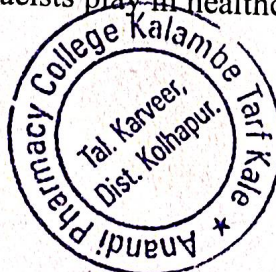
Morning session: The morning initiated by hosting flag and Banner. All the teaching staff and students have been gathered in the premises for the Pharmacist oath.

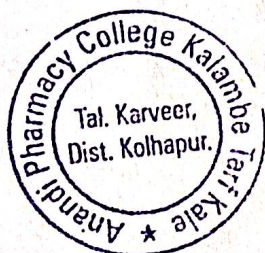

The street play attracted a diverse audience, including families and local residents. After the performance, a Q &A session allowed the audience to ask questions and discuss their experiences with pharmacists.



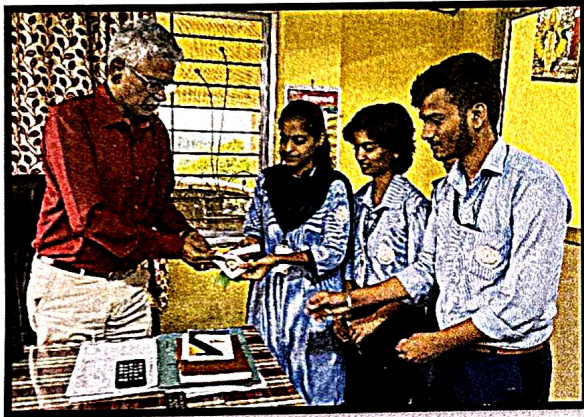
Conclusion

Rules for Poster Making Competition

1. The size of the poster should be 1×1 meter.
2. All lettering and diagrams should be large enough to be read from a minimum of 2 feet.
3. Participants should submit along with the poster, abstract (50-100 words explaining the topic and content of the poster).
4. Name of students, and class should be mentioned on top of the poster.
5. Each Participant can post only one Poster.
6. Place the title at the top. Start with the Introduction at the upper left, and finish with the recommendations at the lower right, with methods and results filling the central space.
7. Marks will be based on creativity, efforts taken, and topic specific content.
8. The certificates will be issued to only participants who will submit the poster.
9. The decision of the jury will be considered final.

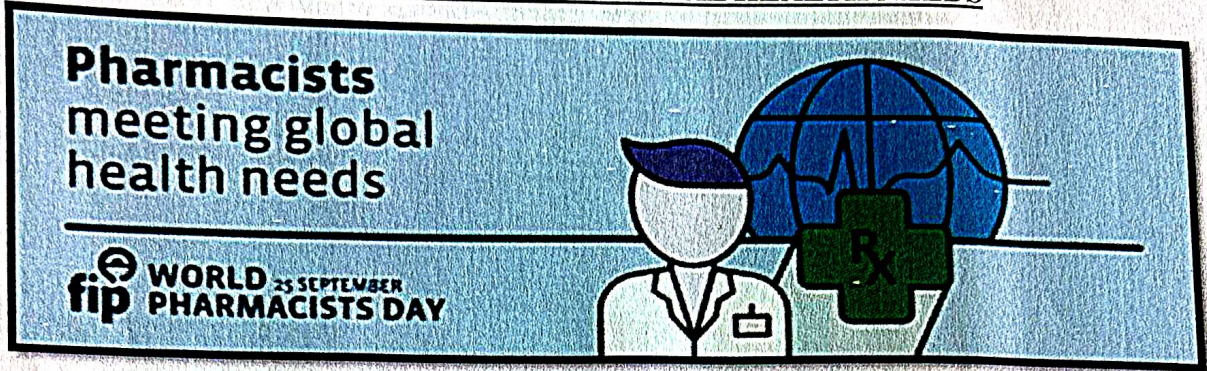

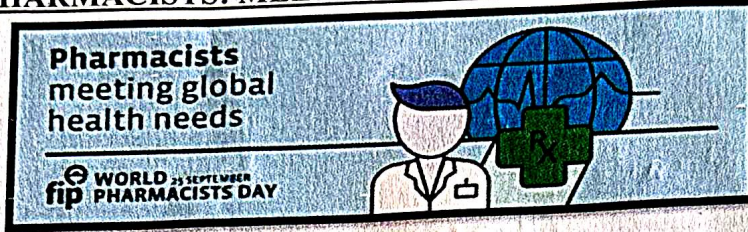

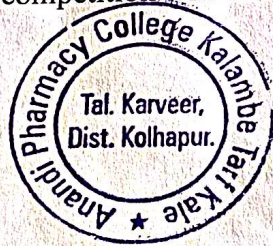
